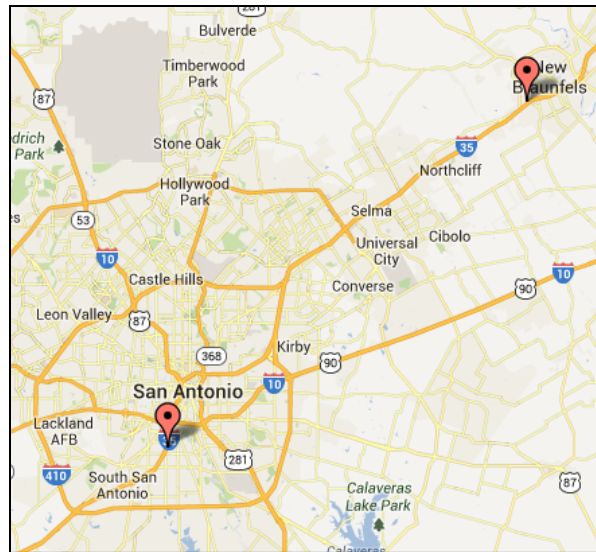

WHAT IS RIVER CITY REHABILITATION CENTER?

River City Rehabilitation Center is an Outpatient Substance Abuse Treatment Clinic based on a Multi-Disciplinary Team Approach.

The team consists of Physicians, Nurses, Pharmacists and a Licensed Professional Counseling Staff.

Medications used in treatment are Methadone, Trexan and Antabuse.

METHADONE AWARENESS

Addiction knows no boundaries...people from all walks of life can become dependent on drugs.

At River City Rehabilitation Center, we use Methadone as part of the treatment for individuals addicted to opiates such as: Codeine, Dilaudid, Heroin, Hydrocodone, Lortab, Lorcet, Percocet, Percodan, Vicodin, Morphine, Oxycodone and Oxycotin.

Methadone is a long-lasting synthetic opiate that acts as a replacement for a compromised endogenous opiate system. The goal of Methadone treatment is to facilitate a more productive lifestyle and to reduce illegal opiate abuse, crime, death, disease and other negative consequences associated with addiction.

Our clinic can assist you in restoring your health, self-respect, integrity, well-being and self-worth, setting you back on the road to a drug free lifestyle.
